We recently got the 2017 year-end numbers. Median prices were up about 2.8% for the Rock County area for 2017, but total sales were slightly down from 2016—due to inventory issues. Nevertheless the last 3 years have all been strong for sales, and 2017 numbers are not far off from the recent record numbers here. If we can do that with so little inventory, imagine where we'll be when the number of homes for sale blossoms!

Don't forget that Realtor® Government Day is only a few days off—February 7th in Madison. There's plenty of space for you to go with FREE registration? We'll learn a few things from our WRA leadership, then go get acquainted with our representatives! Let's make sure that our representatives know we expect their help in protecting the Wisconsin homeowners, and our industry. MLS INFORMATION

*****Compensation Offer Based on Gross Sale Price:**

Offers of compensation made through the MLS must be based upon a percentage of the gross sale price or a specific dollar amount. This applies even in a case where seller-paid concessions/credits are included in the sale price, or in a case where improvements on existing property, or add-ons to new construction are negotiated. If it is your intent to pay a commission based on the net sale price (after seller concessions/credits, improvements, or add-ons are subtracted from the gross sale price), the cooperating broker must agree to this in writing.

***** The Rental Weatherization Program**

The Wisconsin Rental Weatherization program has ended as of January 1, 2018. Any Rental Weatherization provision in a WB form is no longer applicable. Rental Weatherization provisions may be struck from a WB form containing it.

***If you receive an email alerting you that a client has opted out of receiving emails from you via Paragon, this may be because they accidentally clicked on the opt out link within an email, or because Paragon received a bounce back from your clients email provider. To opt them back in, email them the following link or open the link and type in their email

address: <http://p50.fnismls.com/paragonsubscriptions/optin.aspx>. Your client will be sent a confirmation email containing an opt-in option they will need to click on within 72 hours to opt back in. Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis. —While tight inventories continue to constrain sales, the robust economy has fueled demand and pushed sales to record levels for the third straight year. Given our extremely low inventory levels throughout the year, hitting a new record high in sales shows just how hot Wisconsin's housing market really was in 2017.

The other pressure point is price, with median home prices appreciating at more than twice the rate of inflation. The good news is that Wisconsin housing remains relatively affordable, even though it has slipped from last year.

Looking ahead, there are a number of factors likely to impact the existing home market in 2018. Millennials continue to enter the housing market, fueling demand pressures. Mortgage rates should remain low by historical standards. The tight labor market should increase income levels allowing more potential buyers to afford more expensive homes.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for December 2017 is \$138,000 and for the month of December in 2016 it was \$137,250 that was an increase of +0.5% and the Sales for December 2017 is 139 and December of 2016 was 160 that was a decrease of -13.1%.

Annual Housing Statistics—The median price for 2017 was \$140,000 and for 2016 it was \$136,500 that was an increase of +2.6%. The sales for 2017 was 2,327 and in 2016 it was 2,379 that was a decrease of -2.2%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2010, all historical sales volume and median price data at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Techmark system, which accesses MLS data directly and in real time.
